At present, I * is denoted as "absent" in the Transcript of Record of Work of all UG Programmes.

As per the paper read 2nd above, it has been proposed to modify the denotation for grade point I * as " Absent due to genuine reasons" in the Transcript of Record of Work of all UG Programmes, so that it will be beneficial to the students who cannot attend the examinations due to participation in various events / activities, representing the University.

The denotation for grade point I * is modified as " Final exam absent (Genuine Reason)" in the Transcript of Record of Work of all UG Programmes of KAU with effect from the date of issue of this order.
