## C. Agrometeorological Advisories

General conditions	A low pressure area has formed over southeast Arabian Sea & adjoining Lakshadweep area today, the 13th May morning (0830 hrs IST). It is very likely to become well marked over Lakshadweep area by 14th morning, concentrate into a Depression over the same region by 15th morning and intensify into a Cyclonic Storm during the subsequent 24 hours. It is very likely to intensify further and move north-northwestwards towards Gujarat and adjoining Pakistan coasts. It is likely to reach near Gujarat coast around 18th May evening
Precautions	Transport harvested produces like rice, rubber, copra, pulses, vegetables, seeds, etc. and fertilizers from open places to store houses.
	Beware of heavy wind and lightning. Avoid working when there is lightning. Don't rest under the trees and in week shelters.
	Give strong propping to banana, vegetables and other soft stemmed crop plants.
	Neither keep the livestock in open places, nor allow them for grazing. They should be sheltered under strong roofs.
	Postpone activities like fertilizer application, sowing etc till climatic conditions become favourable.
