Weather summary / Alert: As per the forecast of IMD, there is a chance of moderate rainfall in the district and heavy rainfall in isolated places. Above normal rainfall is expected in Kerala.

C. General and Agrometeorological Advisories for Ernakulum District (RRS Vyttila)

Since moderate rainfall is expected, provide proper drainage in the cultivated paddy field, if necessary. The paddy crop, which attained maturity stage can be harvested as early as possible. Provide supports for the bananas. Make the vegetable pandals stronger. Avoid standing in open areas to protect farmers and livestock from lightning and thunder. Special crop management is required for agricultural crops before monsoon season. Proper mulching can be followed to conserve soil moisture.

Rice (Pokkali)	Management	After strengthening the outer bunds, setting the sluices and drying the field, farmers can start preparing mounds and seeds can also be procured.		
Rice	Sheath	To control sheath blight disease in rice, spray 4 gram of		
(Puncha)	Blight	Trifloxystrobin + Tebuconazole mixture in ten litres of water.		
Vegetables	Mites	Spray neem oil garlic emulsion (20 ml neem oil + 20 g garlic paste + 5 g bar soap per litre of water) or 1% azadirachtin (10 ml per litre water) in the initial stages of infestation. In severe cases, spray Spiromesifen 22.9 SC 1 ml per litre of water or Fenazaquin 10 EC 2.5 ml per litre water		
Tree crops	Pink disease	Bordeux mixture to be sprayed after summer showers to prevent the disease.		
Ginger/Turmeric	Foot rot	The seed rhizomes should be socked in 0.3 % mancozeb or pseudomonas solution for 30 minutes for preventing rhizome rot disease. While planting 90 kg FYM mixed with one kg <i>Trichoderma</i> and kept under shade for two weeks with sufficient moisture can be applied.		

Animal Husbandry:- Care should be taken to prevent rat breeding in the premises of cattle shed to prevent leptospirosis. Keep away from open fields to avoid lightning stroke to livestock in the afternoon. (CAADECCS, KVASU,
