CURRENT SYNOPTIC SITUATION: A trough runs from Madhya Maharashtra to Comorin area across interior Karnataka and interior TamilNadu extending upto 0.9 km above mean sea level.

AGRO-METEOROLOGICAL ADVISORIES:

Crop	Pest/ Disease	Advisories
Paddy	-	Land preparation for virippu paddy can be started.
Banana	Sigatoka disease	There is a chance of sigatoka disease in banana. As a precaution, Spray 20 g <i>Pseudomonas</i> per one litre of water.
Pepper	Foot rot	There is a chance of foot rot in pepper. Add 2 kg Trichoderma to a mixture of 90 kg FYM and 10 kg Neemcake and kept for two weeks with sufficient moisture. Add 2.5 kg of this mixture to each matured vine to control foot rot of pepper.
Nutmeg		As a prophylactic measure to prevent the fungal disease in nutmeg. Spray 20g pseudomonas in one litre of water or 1% bordeaux mixture.
Animal Husbandry	Seek advice to prevent ectoparasitic infestations. (CAADECCS, KVASU, Mannuthy)
