CURRENT SYNOPTIC SITUATION: An offshore trough lies from North Maharashtra coast to North Kerala coast. A low pressure area lies over North west Bay of Bengal and adjoining Odisha & Gangetic West Bengal coasts with associated Cyclonic circulation extending upto mid tropospheric levels. It is likely to become more marked during next 24 hours and move west- northwestwards across Odisha

HEAVY RAINFALL WARNING: Day 3: Heavy (7- 11 cm in 24 hours) rainfall is very likely to occur at isolated places in the districts of Thiruvananthapuram ,Kollam, Pathanamthitta, Alappuzha, Kottayam, Idukki, Ernakulam, Thrissur, Malappuram ,Kozhikode, Kannur & Kasaragod.

Day 4: Heavy (7- 11 cm in 24 hours) rainfall is very likely to occur at isolated places in the districts of Idukki, Ernakulam, Thrissur, Palakkad, Malappuram, Kozhikode, Wayanad, Kannur & Kasaragod.

Day 5: Heavy (7- 11 cm in 24 hours) rainfall is very likely to occur at isolated places in the districts of Thiruvananthapuram, Kollam, Pathanamthitta, Alappuzha, Kottayam, Ernakulam, Malappuram, Wayanad & Kasaragod.
