

CURRENT SYNOPTIC SITUATION: An off shore trough runs from south Gujarat coast to Kerala coast.

HEAVY RAINFALL WARNING: Heavy rainfall at a few places and very heavy rainfall at one or two places is most likely to occur in Kerala till the morning of 29^{th} , Heavy rainfall at a few places and very heavy rainfall at one or two places in North Kerala from 29^{th} till the morning of 1^{st} & heavy rainfall at one or two places is most likely to occur in North Kerala from 1^{st} till 2^{nd} morning.

Crop	Stage of the crop / Pest/Disease	Advisories	
Paddy (Jyothi, Kanchana)	Seedling stage	Seedling stage in first paddy crop.	
Coconut	Bud rot	Perforated Mancozeb sachet (5 gm)- 3 no.s can be hung around spindle leaves as a prophylatic measure for rot.	
Nutmeg/Pepper	Quick wilt	Prophylactic spraying of 1% Bordeaux mixture against fungal disease in nutmeg and pepper can be done. There is a chance of Quick wilt disease due to high relative humidity. Apply <i>Trichoderma</i> or <i>pseudomonas</i> culture in soil or 1% Bordeaux mixture can be sprayed on the leaves and small branches.	

Animal Husbandry		Mosquito control measures can be adapted. Cattle should not be allowed graze in water logged areas for avoiding diseases.
		Avoid water logging in cattle sheds. If fever and respiratory distress are noticed consult a veterinary
