Special crop management is required for agricultural crops during monsoon season. Proper drainage facilities have to be ensured. Pesticides should not be applied during rain.

Paddy (Pokkali)	Management	Precautions to be taken against the attack of turtles, rats and purple moorhens.					
Paddy (Virippu)	Seedling stage	The micronutrient deficiency of paddy can be managed by spraying 10 gram of paddy sampoorna in one litter of water. Fertilizer should not be applied during rain.					
Many crops	Giant African Snail	Copper sulphate 3g/ litre or Copper Oxy Chloride 3g/litre or mixture of copper sulphate solution and tobacco decotion can be sprayed on crops. If the population is less, bleaching powder or copper sulphate can be applied around the basins. Overnight traps can be set using papaya leaves and or cabbage leaves and covered with wet gunny bags or jute bag pieces, destroy the trapped snails using common salt. Remove and expose the damaged bark near bases and spray Carbosulphan 0.25% or 10% Bordeaux paste can be painted on the stem base;					
Cucurbitaceous Vegetables	Downy mildew	Due to high relative humidity, there is a chance of downy mildew attack in cucurbitaceous vegetables. Spray 2.5gm Mancozeb per one litre of water under the leaves. Pesticides should not be applied during rain.					
Fisheries	Farmers are advised to make happa for stocking fish fingerlings. Mosquito net or some other clothes can be used for the preparation of happa. Happa of size 2m x 1m x 1m can store 1000 fingerlings.
