Weather summary / Alert: As per the forecast of IMD, there is a chance of light rainfall in the district and Moderate rainfall is expected in isolated places. Above normal rainfall is expected in Kerala.

C. General and Agrometeorological Advisories for Ernakulum District (RRS Vyttila)

Special crop management is required for agricultural crops during monsoon season. Proper drainage facilities have to be ensured. Propping of the banana plants recommended. Additional support of the pandals recommended. Pesticides should not be applied during rainy period.

Vegetables (Cowpea)	Anthracnose disease	During rainy season, there is a chance of Anthracnose disease in Cowpea. As a prophylactic measure, apply 1% Bordeaux mixture or spray pseudomonas 20 gm per one litre of water. Pesticides should not be applied during rain.	
Cucurbitaceous Vegetables	Downy mildew	During rainy season, there is a chance of downy mildew attack in cucurbitaceous vegetables. Spray 2.5gm Mancozeb per one litre of water under the leaves. Pesticides should not be applied during rainy period.	

Animal Husbandry: - Sundry the cattle feed frequently to avoid fungal growth. Give foot and mouth disease (FMD) vaccination to the animal. Don't allow the animals go to water logged areas in order to avoid anthrax and foot lesions. (CAADECCS, KVASU, Mannuthy).
