C. General and Agrometeorological Advisories for Ernakulum District (RRS Vyttila)

Special crop management is required for agricultural crops during monsoon season. Proper drainage facilities have to be ensured. If the soil is more acidic, add lime as per soil testing. Pesticides should not be applied during rainy period. Provide supports to banana crops. Make the vegetable pandals stronger. To protect farmers and livestock from lightning and thunder avoid standing in open areas.

Crop	-	Crop/ Animal Advisory		
Paddy (Pokkali)	Stem borer	Release of egg parasitoids Trichogramma japonicum (5cc / Ha) at weekly intervals from 15-30 days after transplantation immediately after noticing stem borer activity.		
Paddy (Virippu)	Rice bug	Rice bug Fish amino acid @ 20 ml /L water or Azadirachtin (3000 ppm 10 ml / L water can be sprayed. Farmers those who cultivate for second crop can initiate preparations for nursey.		
Ginger	Rhizome rot	There is a chance of rhizome rot disease in ginger. As a prophylactic measure spray, 2 gram Copper oxychloride or 1.5 gram copper hydroxide per one litre of water.		
Vegetables (Cowpea)	Anthracnose disease	During rainy season, there is a chance of Anthracnose disease in Cowpea. To control spray Carbendazim one gram per one litre of water. Pesticides should not be applied during rain.		

Animal Husbandry: - Cattle feed should be stored on a wooden board or iron board. If moisture is in the cattle feed it may cause deadly fungal growth. Care should be taken to prevent rat breeding in the premises of cattle shed to prevent leptospirosis. (CAADECCS, KVASU, Mammuthy).
