Weather summary / Alert: Moderate rainfall is expected in the district and heavy rainfall in isolated places. Normal rainfall is expected in Kerala.

B. Agrometeorological Advisories for crop protection & management

General Advisory: Provide sufficient drainage facilities in agricultural lands.

Spraying should be done only on dry/clear weather conditions.

Do not keep the harvested produces like rice, rubber, copra and fertilizers at open places.

The wind speed may increase. Give strong propping to banana and staking to vegetables.

Rice (General)	Sheath rot and sheath blight		Spray Hexaconazole 5EC 1.5 ml per litre after draining the field	
Turmeric	Leaf blight & blotch		Spray and drench Carbendazim + Mancozeb 2g per litre of water or Mancozeb 3g per litre or 1% Bordeaux mixture. Rotation of crops to be followed strictly. Avoid using rhizomes of diseased plants as seeds. Seed rhizomes to be dipped in Bordeaux mixture for half an hour and dry in shade before storing.	
Tree crops	Pink disease		Drench and spray Hexaconazole 5EC 2ml per litre. Once the rain subsides, cut the affected branches or swab 10% Bordeaux paste or Copper oxy chloride (10g per litre).	
Fish	This is the time of pond preparation for culturing fresh water fishes. Tilapia and Anabas which			
farming	can be harvested within a span of six months are good options for fish culture. Farmers can use			
	floating happas for stocking fish seeds to overcome flood.
