Rice (Mundakan) Milky stage	Rice bug	There is a chance of appearance of rice bug in paddy. To control,		
		spray 2 ml malathion per one litre of water. Pesticides application		
		should be done either before 9 am or after 3 pm. Otherwise, the		
		pesticide application will adversely affect the pollination.		
	-	Boron deficiency is seen more during dry weather. Spray one gram		
Banana		borax per one litre of water.		
Chilli		There is a chance of white fly attack in chilli. Apply 2% neem oil		
	White fly	garlic emulsion or spray 20g Lecanicillium lecanii per one litre of		
		water in ten days intervals.		
Animal Husbandry		Vaccinate animals against foot and mouth disease and hemorrhagic		
		septicemia. (CAADECCS, KVASU, Mannuthy)
