| General Advisories: As a precaution, use bio-pesticides to control the crop pests and diseases. <br> Milky stage |  | Rice bug |
| Banana | - | There is a chance of appearance of rice bug in paddy. To control, <br> spray 2 ml malathion per one litre of water. Pesticides application <br> should be done either before 9 am or after 3 pm. Otherwise, the <br> pesticide application will adversely affect the pollination. |
| Chilli | White fly | Boron deficiency is seen more during dry weather. Spray one gram <br> borax per one litre of water. |
| There is a chance of white fly attack in chilli. Apply 2\% neem oil <br> garlic emulsion or spray 20g Lecanicillium lecanii per one litre of <br> water in ten days intervals. |  |  |
| Animal Husbandry |  | Vaccinate animals against foot and mouth disease and hemorrhagic <br> septicemia. (CAADECCS, KVASU, Mannuthy) |
