

Agro Meteorological Advisories:

Crop	Crop stage / Pest/Disease	Advisories	
Paddy		Puncha is in seedling stage.	
Coconut	Leaf eating caterpiller	Due to increase in temperature there is a chance of leaf eating caterpillar in coconut tree. The affected leaves may be cut and burnt. Arrange for the release of larval/pupal parasitoids. Spray the undersurface of the fronds with Quinalphos 0.05%.	
Pepper	-	Pepper vines shall be planted in nursery beds for rooting. matured vines can be cut into 2-3 nodded cuttings and shall be planted in polythene bags for germination. Adding VAM culture to potting mixture can yield healthy and disease resistant plants.	
Nutmeg	Management	Mulching is recommended to protect the trees from drought and sun scorching. Irrigate the plants.	
Vegetables	Jassid and whitefly	Due to high temperature, there is a chance of attack of white fly and jassid in vegetables. Stunted growth caused by them can be controlled by hanging yellow boards painted with castor oil.	
Animal Husbandry	Adopt measures to eradicate external parastic infestations in animals. (CAADECCS, KVASU, Mannuthy)
