Weather summary / Alert: Since dry weather condition is prevailed, irrigation of crops can be continued, when required. Normal rainfall is expected in Kerala.

C. General and Agro meteorological Advisories

The following are immediate steps to be followed to protect farmers, plants, and birds from the summer heat. Drink plenty of clean water from time to time to prevent dehydration. Avoid going out in hot weather to get rid of sunburn while going. Try to use a hat or an umbrella to prevent direct sunlight. Since dry and hot weather is prevailed, crops can be irrigated to ensure adequate soil moisture. Crops should not be irrigated during strong sunlight. Drip irrigation can reduce water loss to some extent.

Animal Husbandry: - Pets, domestic animals and birds should be provided with adequate drinking water and should be protected from the solar radiation. Adequate ventilation should be arranged in their living space. Do not let the cattle graze during hot weather. (CAADECCS, KVASU, Mannuthy).
