AGRO-METEOROLOGICAL ADVISORIES:

Crop	Pest/ Disease	Advisories
General Advisories: As a precaution, use bio-pesticides to control the crop pests and diseases.		
Rice (Mundakan) Harvesting stage	-	Rice is in harvesting stage.
Banana	-	Apply lime @ 250g/plant to reduce the calcium deficiency in the soil.
Coconut	White fly	There is a chance of whitefly attack on coconut leaves during dry spell and they are controlled by beneficiary insects available in nature. If the whitefly attack is severe, spray 2% neem oil emulsion on the leaves.
	Sooty mould	There is a chance of sooty mould in coconut leaves during dry spell. Apply starch solution to control them.
Cucumber	Pumpkin Beetle	Sowing of cucumber can be done. Apply neem cake at the base for preventing pumpkin beetle.
Animal Husbandry		Deworming of animals should be done only after dung sample examination. In calves first dose of medicine should be given within 15 days of age. (CAADECCS, KVASU, Mannuthy)
