CURRENT SYNOPTIC SITUATION: A cyclonic circulation lies over south Tamil Nadu and adjoining Comorin area extending upto 0.9 km above mean sea level. A trough/wind discontinuity runs from above cyclonic circulation to north Interior Karnataka at 0.9 km above mean sea level.

General Advisories: As a precaution, use bio-pesticides to control the crop pests and diseases.				
Rice (Mundakan) Harvesting stage	-	Rice is in harvesting stage.		
	-	Boron deficiency is seen more during dry weather. Spray one		
Banana		gram borax per one litre of water.		
Coconut	White fly	There is a chance of whitefly attack on coconut leaves during dry spell and they are controlled by benificiary insects available in nature. If the whitefly attack is severe, spray 2% neem oil emulsion on the leaves.		
	Sooty mould	There is a chance of sooty mould in coconut leaves during dry spell. Apply starch solution to control them.		
Cucumber	Pumpkin Beetle	Sowing of cucumber can be done. Apply neem cake at the base for preventing pumpkin beetle.		
Animal Husbandry		Give 30g sodium bicarbonate with one tea spoon yeast mixed in feed to avoid indigestion and acidity. (CAADECCS, KVASU, Mannuthy)
