Special crop management is required for agricultural crops during monsoon season. Proper drainage facilities have to be ensured. If the soil is more acidic, add lime as per soil testing. Pesticides should not be applied during rainy period. Provide supports to banana crops. Make the vegetable pandals stronger. To protect farmers and livestock from lightning and thunder avoid standing in open areas.

		As a prophylactic measure to control quick wilt of pepper, add 2 kg		
		Trichoderma to a mixture of 90 kg FYM and 10 kg neem cake and kept		
Pepper	Quick wilt	for two weeks with sufficient moisture and add 2.5 kg to the base of		
		each matured pepper vine		
Ginger	Rhizome rot	There is a chance of rhizome rot disease in ginger. As a prophylactic		
		measure spray, 2 gram Copper oxychloride or 1.5 gram copper		
		hydroxide per one litre of water.
