C. General and Agrometeorological Advisories for Thrissur District

Since dry weather condition is prevailed, irrigation of crops can be continued, if needed. Since the wind speed may increase, give strong propping to banana and staking to vegetables. Prophylactic measures to control crop pests & diseases can be taken to avoid their spread.

| Crop | Pest/ Disease | Crop/ Animal Advisory |

| Rice (Mundakan) Maturity stage | Rice bug | There is a chance of appearance of rice bug in paddy. To control, spray 2 ml malathion per one litre of water. Pesticides application should be done either before 9 am or after 3 pm. Otherwise, the pesticide application will adversely affect the pollination. |
| | Bacterial Leaf blight | To control the spread of bacterial leaf blight in paddy, spray 6 g of streptocycline in 20 litre of water. |
| Banana | Fertilizer 30 grams of urea and 60 grams of potash can be applied to e application plant of three months old. | |
| Chilli, Brinjal White fly | | There is a chance of white fly attack in chilli and brinjal. Apply 2% neem oil garlic emulsion or spray 20g <i>Lecanicillium lecanii</i> per one litre of water in ten days intervals. |

Animal Husbandry- Contact nearby veterinary hospitals to vaccinate the animals against infectious diseases. Care should be taken to avoid fungal growth in the cattle feed (CAADECCS, KVASU, Mannuthy).
