C. General and Agrometeorological Advisories for Thrissur District

The following are immediate steps to be followed protect farmers, plants, and birds from the summer heat. Avoid going out in hot weather as much as possible. That way you can get rid of sunburn. While working in the farm, try to use a hat or umbrella to prevent direct sunlight. Drink plenty of clean water from time to time to prevent dehydration. As the climate is hot and dry, irrigate the crops as required to ensure adequate soil moisture. Irrigate only, when there is no strong sunlight. Drip irrigation can reduce water loss to some extent.

Coconut & Arecanut	Management	A CANA	Mulch the basin of coconut & arecanut. With organic material to protect them from heat. This way the soil moisture can be retained.		
Banana	Rhizome Weevil	X	During this special weather condition, there is a chance of Rhizome Weevil attack in banana. As a precaution, apply néem cake @ 1 kg/plant at the time of planting. Cut and remove the outer layer of the rhizome and sundry for 3-4 days after smearing it with slurry of cow dung and ash.		
Vegetables (Bhindi)	Jassid's		Due to increase in atmospheric temperature, the attack of Jassid's in Bhindi was increased. They can be controlled by applying 2% neem oil emulsion once in a week or by spraying Lecanicillium lecanii at 20 g per litre of water.		
Animal Husbandry	Pets and domestic animals & birds should be provided with adequate fresh water a protection from the sun and heat. Adequate ventilation should be arranged in their living space. Do not let the cattle graze during hot weather. (CAADECCS, KVASU, Mannuthy).
