Farmers are advised to avoid direct sunlight to prevent sunburn. The crops should be irrigated at critical stages. Drip irrigation can be recommended to reduce water loss. Proper mulching can be followed to conserve soil moisture.

Rice (Puncha) Harvesting stage	Rice bug	There is a chance of appearance of rice bug in paddy. To control, spray 2 ml malathion per one litre of water. Pesticides application should be done either before 9 am or after 3 pm. Otherwise, the pesticide application will adversely affect the pollination.		
Coconut	Management	During the beginning of southwest monsoon season, one- kilogram lime can be applied per one matured palm by opening the coconut basin.		
		There is a chance of sigatoka disease in banana. As a
