Weather summary / Alert: -. As per the forecast of IMD, there is a chance of light rainfall in the district. Thunderstorm accompanied by lightning and gusty winds is very likely to occur at one or two places over Kerala on 02<sup>nd</sup> May to 06<sup>th</sup> May 2025. Normal to above normal rainfall is expected in Kerala.

Maximum temperatures are very likely to be around 36°C in 02nd May 2025. Hot & Humid weather is very likely to prevail over the district except in hilly areas due to high temperature and humidity.
