Rice (Puncha)	Harvesting stage	Since there is a chance of lodging due to water logging, provide proper drait facilities.		
Rice (virippu)	Land preparation	Land preparation and nursery for virippu paddy (Rainfed) can be started.		
Banana	Sigatoka disease	During rainy season, there is a chance of sigatoka disease in banana. prophylactic measure, spray 20 g Pseudomonas per one liter of water. Pes should not be applied during rainy period. Proper drainage facilities have ensured.		
Pepper East rot Trichoderma to a mixture of 90 kg FYM and 10 kg neem of		ophylactic measure to manage foot rot during rainy season, add 2 kg erma to a mixture of 90 kg FYM and10 kg neem cake and kept for two vith sufficient moisture. Add 2.5 kg of this mixture to the base of each pepper vine. Proper drainage facilities have to be ensured		
Animal	Avoid water logging near the cattle shed. Ensure proper ventilation in the cattle shed.
