C. General and Agrometeorological Advisories for Thrissur District

Special crop management is required for agricultural crops during monsoon season. Proper drainage facilities have to be ensured. Pesticides should not be applied during rain.

Crop	Pest/ Disease		Crop/ Animal Advisory	
Paddy (virippu) Tillering stage	Bacterial Leaf blight	During rainy season, there is a chance of Bacterial Leaf blight in rice. As a prophylactic measure, spray 20g of pseudomonas in one litre of water. Pesticides should not be applied during rain.		
Coconut	Bud rot	During rainy season, there is a chance of bud rot disease in coconut. As a prophylactic measure, 1% Bordeaux mixture can be sprayed on coconut crown. Pesticides should not be applied during rain.		
Banana	Rhizome rot	Due to the increase in rainfall, there is a chance of Rhizome rot in banana. As a prophylactic measure, drench the basin with three litre of pseudomonas solution (20g per one liter of water). Pesticides should not be applied during rain.		
Ginger and Turmeric	Rhizome rot	During rainy season, there is a chance of rhizome rots in ginger a turmeric. As a prophylactic measure spray 20 gram Pseudomonas in one li of water and drench the basin. Pesticides should not be applied during rain		
Animal	Avoid water logging in the cattle shed premises to prevent mosquito breeding.			
Husbandry (CAADECCS, KVASU, Mannuthy).	If required apply mosquito repellant or fly repellant on the animal body and in the cattle shed as per the direction of experts.
