Weather summary / Alert: As per the forecast of IMD, intensity of rainfall is expected to decrease in the district. Normal rainfall is expected in Kerala.

C. General and Agrometeorological Advisories for Thrissur District

Special crop management is required for agricultural crops during monsoon season. Proper drainage facilities have to be ensured. Propping of banana plants is recommended. Additional support for vegetable pandals should be strengthened. Pesticides should not be applied during rainy period.

Pest/ Disease	Crop/ Animal Advisory
Bacterial Leaf blight	During rainy season, there is a chance of Bacterial Leaf blight in rice. As a prophylactic measure, spray 20g of pseudomonas in one litre of water. Pesticides should not be applied during rain.
Rhizome rot	During rainy season, there is a chance of Rhizome rot in banana. As a prophylactic measure, drench the basin with 3 litre of pseudomonas solution (20g per one liter of water). Pesticides should not be applied during rain.
Quick wilt	Proper drainage facilities have to be ensured. As a prophylactic measure to control quick wilt of pepper, add 2 kg Trichoderma to a mixture of 90 kg FYM and 10 kg neem cake and kept for two weeks with sufficient moisture. Add 2.5 kg of this mixture to the base of each matured pepper vine.
Leaf fall	As a precautionary measure to manage leaf fall in nutmeg, spray 1% Bordeaux mixture. Pesticides should not be applied during rainy period. Proper drainage facilities have to be ensured

feed it may cause deadly fungal growth. Foot and mouth disease (FMD) vaccination has to be given to the animal. If leg lameness or fever was observed, immediate medical attention should be given. (CAADECCS, KVASU, Mannuthy).
