Paddy (virippu) Tilleringstage	Management	In order to reduce the micronutrient deficiency in paddy, spray 10 grams of sampoornamixture of paddyin one liter of water. Sampoorna mixture of paddyis available at the Kerala Agricultural Universityandit containsmicro nutrients like magnesium, sulphur, boron, zinc, copper, iron, manganese and molybdenum. Fertilizers like 20 kg of urea and 10 to 12 kg of potash per acre can be applied for shortduration and medium duration varieties.			
Banana	Rhizome rot	Banana is prone to rhizome rot due to continuous rainfall. As a preventive measure, mix 20 grams of Pseudomonas in one liter of water and drench each banana basin with three liters of pseudomonas solution.			
Pepper	Foot rot	There is a chance of foot rot disease in pepperdue to high humidity caused be continuous rainfall. As a prophylactic measure, spray 1% Bordeaux mixture. As precaution 2.5 to 3 grams of copper oxy chloride per one litre of water can be drenched the basinfor 3 to 5 times.			
Ginger	Stem borer	There is a chance of stem borer in ginger. Spray 20 g ofBeauveria per one li water to control stem borer.			

Animal Husbandry-Deworming of animals should be done only after dung sample examination. In calves first dose ofdeworming medicine can be given within 15 days of age. (CAADECCS, KVASU, Mannuthy).
