INTRODUCTION

The Kerala Agricultural University is an institution which came into existence on the 24 February, 1971 by the Act passed by the Government of Kerala. The University is the principal instrument of Kerala state in providing human resources, skills and technology required for the sustainable development of its agriculture, agricultural engineering, horticulture and forestry by integrating education, research and extension.

The University fulfills its mission through a network of institutions spread throughout the State consisting of three Faculties under which are 8 constituent Colleges, 6 Regional Agricultural Research Stations, 17 Research Stations, one Central Training Institute, one Communication Centre and seven Krishi Vigyan Kendras. There is a network of libraries, including a Central Library in the main campus, constituent Colleges, Research Stations and KVKs.

Post-graduate programmes are offered in almost all the disciplines with specializations related to Agriculture, Agricultural Engineering and Forestry. The university offers post-graduate programmes on Master's degree in 34 disciplines and Doctoral programmes in 25 disciplines.

c) Ph.D in Community Science (Food and Nutrition)

M Sc. in Community Science (Food and Nutrition) or equivalent recognized by KAU.

d) Ph.D in Rural Marketing Management

Master's Degree in the respective discipline/related discipline from the faculty concerned of KAU/ State Agricultural Universities or a recognized equivalent qualification by KAU. Basic Degree UG 4 years and Master's degree 2 years from SAUs recognized by KAU will be strictly followed for admissions.

3. System of Teaching and Evaluation

Semester system of instruction and internal/external evaluation will be followed.

4. Reservation of seats and admission for sponsored candidates

> 30% of the seats shall be reserved for the eligible ICAR candidates on the basis of All

India Entrance Examination conducted by ICAR. At the time of admission, ICAR candidates have to fill the Bio data and remit the fees as prescribed by KAU.

Number of students from outside Kerala is restricted to 10% of the total PG/Ph D seats of KAU, in addition to ICAR allotment.

In service candidates

Candidates sponsored by the Govt. of Kerala are admitted over and above the intake capacity subject to availability of faculty and facilities. Intending candidates will have to submit their application through their employers concerned within the stipulated time and should attach a certificate of sponsorship and experience from the concerned employer. They should also satisfy the required qualification for admission. Sponsored candidate is a candidate deputed by the respective development department, research institutions of national importance, Commodity Boards and other Government and Quasi Government development institutions. The expenditure towards the Post Graduate programme of such students will be met by the sponsoring agency or the student.

Two seats for <u>M Sc. (Ag.)</u> will be reserved for the candidates from the Union Territory of Lakshadweep provided that the entire expenditure on account of the programme is met by the Union Territory of Lakshadweep. At the time of admission, candidates have to fill the Bio data and remit the fees as prescribed by KAU.

KAU sponsored candidates

KAU sponsored candidates have to apply via the admission portal for admission to PhD programmes. Candidates must attach a No Objection Certificate issued by the Registrar along with the hard copy of application and submit the same through the Head of Institution. Advance copy will not be considered. Admissions will be considered based on granting of study leave by KAU, subject to fulfilling of other requirements for admission.

5. How to Apply

Prospectus for admission is available in the KAU website www.admissions.kau.in.
Candidate should submit the application online after registering in the website. Applications submitted late or found defective or incomplete in any manner or which do not contain any of the enclosures specified are liable to be summarily rejected. The candidates are advised to read the instructions given in the website carefully before filling up the application (Appendix I). Hard copy of application of employed candidates should be routed through their Heads of Institutions. On successful submission of the application, the candidates will receive an auto generated email.

Payment of Application Fee

Application fee can be paid online by using the internet facility "SB COLLECT" of State Bank of India for which a link is provided in the application portal and after payment of application fee, candidate should take a print out of **online payment receipt** from website. Candidates can also remit the application fee directly at any of the branches of State Bank of India by showing the chalan generated through "SB COLLECT" and the bank will issue an Online Receipt on payment of the same. Any other mode of payment will not be accepted. **The Application fee /additional fee once remitted will not be refunded under any circumstances**.

NB:- The candidates are required to enter details of the fee paid in the online application form. Application forms without receipt of online payment attached will be summarily rejected. Candidates must ensure the payment before attaching the online receipt of payment.

6. Application Enclosures

Each application should contain the following documents as enclosures:

- a. Online payment receipt of the application fee.
- b. Scanned copies of certificates in proof of mark list of qualifying examination/ provisional degree certificate/ degree certificate with OGPA.
- c. Valid ICAR Score Card (2025-2026), Valid GATE Score Card in case of M.Tech Programmes
- d. PwD/ Community/ NCLC/ EWS Certificate in case of reservation Candidates.
- e. Certificates in proof of experience, sports, arts, publication.
- f. The details of published papers should be furnished as follows:
 - Original research paper
 - Text books (authored or edited)
 - Chapter in Text Book
 - Review articles in research journals/Research note
 - Popular science articles
- g. A 'no objection certificate' and experience certificate obtained from the controlling officer concerned in the case of in-service candidates. Registrar will be the controlling officer for KAU employees.

7. Penalty for false information

Any candidate who is found to have willfully or otherwise furnished any particulars which are false or has suppressed material facts or does not satisfy the requisite qualification for admission shall be disqualified. They shall not be allowed to continue on the rolls of the University, if it is detected at any stage of his/her studentship in the University. In case the candidate has already graduated from the University, then the degree awarded by the University will be withdrawn.

8. SELECTION

a. Masters

Selection of candidates for the master's degree programmes will be based on ICAR entrance examinations conducted for the academic session 2025-26 for M.Sc. (Ag.), M.Sc. (Hort.), M.Sc. (Forestry) and M.Tech (Agrl.Engg.) The candidates should attend the Entrance Examination in the relevant subject group as prescribed by ICAR, to be eligible for admission. KAU will conduct separate entrance exam for Community Science and Co-operation & Banking courses.

Candidates with valid **GATE score** also will be considered for admission to **M.Tech. Programme** in Agricultural Engineering. GATE score in Agricultural Engineering will be considered for admission to all M.Tech. disciplines of Agricultural Engineering. GATE score in Food Technology will be considered for admission to M.Tech. (Processing & Food Engineering).

An ICAR score card of relevant year of admission in the Major Subject Groups as prescribed by ICAR for admission through AIEEA, under the corresponding Faculty of KAU is mandatory for considering for admission at KAU

Reservation rules of Government of Kerala will be applicable for admission to all PG/ Ph.D programmes. A detailed list of seats reserved to various communities for this year admission is appended as Annexure - I & II.

9. Rejection of application and disqualification of candidates

- **1.** Applications defective or incomplete in any manner or which do not contain any of the enclosures specified above are liable to be summarily rejected.
- 2. Applicants who attempt to canvas or influence directly or otherwise will be disqualified.

10. Entrance Examination

Candidates will be required to attend Entrance Examination (with objective type questions) for M.Sc. (C&B), M.Sc. (Community Science), Ph.D Rural Marketing Management and Ph.D Community Science, at the place and time to be notified by the University at their own expense. Their minimum qualifying marks for entrance examination will be 50%.

11. GENERAL PROCEDURES AND IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS ON MODE OF ADMISSION

Admission to various PG/Ph.D programmes under Kerala Agricultural University for the academic year 2025-26 will be conducted through online mode.

The online applications received will be verified by the Committee constituted for each Faculty of the University and on completion of verification, provisional rank list & rejected list will be published in the official admission website of Kerala Agricultural University.

It is mandatory that the students should upload certificates proving their basic qualification for admission to the programme, before the last date for submission of online application, failing which their applications will be summarily rejected without further notice.

The candidates included in the Rejected List for want of certificates proving their basic qualification for admission to the programme concerned, will not be allowed to submit certificates, after the last date prescribed for submission of Online Application, under any circumstances.

The candidates included in the rejected list for other reasons shall submit the documents to prove their part, strictly within the time prescribed by the University.

Choice filling

The process of Choice – filling is a one time procedure.

During this process, candidates can select the colleges/disciplines they wish to attend.

It is obligatory that the candidates included in the Provisional Rank List must log into their registered account on the admissions portal and select their preferred courses or colleges in the order they want.

Candidates who have not submitted their Choices, will not be considered for any subsequent round of admission/allotment and no requests in this regard will be considered by the University.

Candidates can choose any number of options from the provided list and they have the flexibility to add or delete choices and rearrange them according to their preferences. The candidates should keep a copy of the choice list they submitted for future reference.

Once choices are finalized and submitted candidates can make no further changes.

The provision for filling choices will be automatically locked after the stipulated time and date prescribed for the same.

INDIVIDUAL REQUESTS on changing the choices once submitted, extension of time for choice filling, vague claims on technical errors committed and that for fresh choice filling consequent rounds of allotment will not be considered by the University, under any stances.

As the allotment will purely be based on the choices, the applicants should take utmost care while submitting their choices in regard to their preferred College/discipline.

The candidates included in the Provisional Allotment List should physically report at the date, time and venue as announced by the University with all necessary documents to confirm their admission.

All announcements of admission for publishing of Provisional Rank List/Fresh Choice Filling, Confirmation/Up gradation & Physical reporting, and conduct of Spot admission, if any, etc will be published ONLY THROUGH the website www.admissions.kau.in & www.kau.in. No individual communication will be made by the University in this regard and hence, the students should visit the websites for updates, at frequent intervals to ensure that no deadline is missed.

12. Announcement of results

The list of candidates provisionally selected for admission and the dates on which they have to remit the fees and physically join the course will be published through KAU Website www.admissions.kau.in

13. Admission

Originals of all certificates and documents should be produced at the time of admission. Those who do not produce the original documents at the time of admission shall forfeit their seat and the seats will be allotted to the next eligible candidate from the rank list/waiting list or in any other manner deemed fit by the University.

Candidates selected will be admitted to the course, provided they pay the prescribed fees in full on the due date fixed.

In the case of those candidates provisionally selected for admission who have not paid the fees on time and not joined the course on the date fixed, their claims for admission will be cancelled without notice and the seat thus becoming vacant will be filled up with eligible candidates, if any, from the rank/ wait list.

Candidates in Government service/University service should make their own arrangements to get relieved from their posts in time.

- k) Medical fitness certificate obtained from a Govt. Medical Officer not below the rank of Asst. Surgeon.
- 1) Score card of ICAR JRF/SRF or GATE Score Card (as applicable)

Candidates who secured their degrees from Universities outside the Kerala State should produce Migration Certificate within one month of provisional admission.

- Note: 1. Candidates whose original certificates are in any language other than English should produce translate certificate from competent authority.
 - 2. Kindly visit the University website (www.kau.in) for updates at frequent intervals.

All those who take admission and discontinue the course shall be liable to pay liquidated damages to the University as decided by the authorities.

The Registrar, Kerala Agricultural University is authorized to close the admission at any date after the commencement of first semester of course.

A student provisionally admitted to the programmes should physically report to the Dean of Faculty/ Dean concerned on the date of registration with the Bio-data cum Admit Card and all certificate in physical. Failure to report at the college/ institution without prior permission will lose their admission without further notice.

ICAR candidates should report for admission at KAU Head Quarters on the date and time announced by KAU with the documents prescribed by ICAR. Colleges will be allotted to the candidates **considering their option and the availability of faculty for research guidance at college**.

14. Residential Facilities

Hostel facilities will be provided depending on availability.

15. Fees

The fees for Post-graduate courses are as indicated in Annexure-III, but are liable to be revised by the University and admitted students shall follow it. A special caution deposit of Rs.3000/- is to be paid at the time of admission in the case of candidates from outside the State of Kerala. This will be refunded when he/she leaves the University after completion of the course.

Note: Fees once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.

Fee exemptions to the SC/ST students are applicable to only those who belong to the state of Kerala. SC/ST candidates with nativity other than Kerala will be treated as General Candidates.

The High Court of Kerala will be the only judicial body to decide on the disputes arising if any, in the matter of admission.

The prospectus is subject to further modification/ addition as may be considered necessary by the University and will be issued as executive orders/ notifications and the students are liable to obey the rules and regulations so amended or modified.

NOTICE

Ragging is a criminal offense as per the 'Kerala Prohibition of Ragging Act 1997 of Kerala'. Students indulging in such activities will be punished as per law.


