Qualification

Essential

- Bachelor's degree from the concerned Faculty recognized by Kerala Agricultural University.
- Master's Degree in the relevant subject recognized by the Kerala Agricultural University with a minimum of 55% marks in the traditional system or its equivalent.
A relaxation of 5% shall be allowed at the master's level for the Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe/ Differently-abled (Physically and visually differently-abled) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic record during direct recruitment to teaching positions. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based on only the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedures.
- Qualifying in the National Eligibility Test conducted by the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR)/UGC/Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR)/All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) or similar test accredited by the UGC.
- In the absence of NET qualified candidates, applicants with Masters' Degree in the concerned discipline recognized by KAU will be considered.

Desirable

1. Knowledge in Malayalam language to read and write.
2. Ph.D. in the relevant subject recognized by Kerala Agricultural University.

Age Limit

The candidates for the post of Assistant Professor shall not be over 50 years as on 01.01.2026. The age limit is relaxable in the case of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Communities as prescribed in the Kerala State and Subordinate Services Rule 1958 as amended from time to time.


