BACKGROUND:

India is the largest producer, consumer and exporter of spices. Spices and value added products provide immense job opportunities to micro, small, medium & large scale enterprises. Besides, COVID 19 pandemic has further given an impetus to spice as immunity boosters thereby increasing its global demand. Spices of Kerala, endemic to the Western Ghats are of exquisite quality due to the unique tropical climate. Kerala Agricultural University (KAU) has contributed several new spice varieties, developed new and improved techniques for spice cultivation and processing. In view of the current international trade concerns and volatility in the pricing of spices, University has rendered recommendations in policies pertaining to marketing and prices, on the basis of supply demand predictions. The Pesticide Residue Research and Analytical Laboratory, Vellayani, KAU, regularly monitors the pesticide residue in spices.
