1.	Talc powder (quantity of 5-10 tones)	Talc powder <i>i.e.</i> , hydrous magnesium silicate with a chemical formula of $Mg_3Si_4O_{10}(OH)_2$ with neutralizing value in between 90-95 per cent and pH in between 7 and 9 with minimum microbial contaminant.

The price quoted should be inclusive of taxes and other government levies. Special discount offered if any should be mentioned in the quote itself.
