TENDER NOTICE

Sealed tenders are invited from competent firms/contractors for the “**Asphalting work of severely damaged Farm road (starting from PRS gate)**” at Pepper Research Station, Panniyur as detailed below. The tender will be accepted upto **3.00 PM on 18.03.2025**. The tenders received after the stipulated time will not be considered at any circumstances. The received tenders will be opened in the chamber of Asst. Professor & Head, Pepper Research Station, Panniyur at **03.30 PM** on the same day. The bidder or their representative (Not more than 1) may be present, if so they desire, at the opening of tenders. The details, tender form, format of agreements etc can be downloaded from the KAU website www.kau.edu/tenders.

Program of work

- i. Prepare a detailed program showing the stages, sequence and timing of all the parts of work. It should include the resources, men, material, equipment required with clear critical path to execute the work
- ii. The bidders shall agree to execute the work progressively in co-ordination with the concerned staffs of PRS.
- iii. Timeline should be clearly defined. They should include estimated completion date and number of working days.
- iv. Road cutting and making good – Scarifying the existing bituminous road surface to a depth of 50 mm and disposal of scarified material with in all lifts by mechanical means
- v. Construction of granular sub-base by providing graded material spreading in uniform layers on a prepared surface, mixing by mix in-place method with rotavator at OMC, and compacting to achieve the desired density, complete as per clause 401. Grading IV- For lower sub-base – Mix in place method
- vi. WMM – This work shall consist of providing, laying, spreading and compacting graded stone aggregate to Wet Mix Macadam specification including premixing the Material with water at OMC, laying in uniform layers in sub-base/base course on well prepared surface and compacting to achieve the desired density.
- vii. Prime coat – This work shall consist of providing and applying primer coat with bitumen emulsion (SS) on prepared surface of granular Base including clearing of road surface and spraying primer using mechanical means
- viii. Application of tack coat – Providing and applying tack coat with bitumen emulsion (RS) using emulsion pressure distributor at the rate of 0.25 – 0.30 kg per sq.m on the prepared Granular Surface cleaned with mechanical broom.
- ix. Providing, laying and rolling of close-graded premix surfacing material of 20mm thickness composed of 11.2mm to 0.09mm (Type-A) aggregates using viscosity grade bitumen (VG-30) to the required line, grade and level to serve as wearing course on a

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previously prepared base, including mixing, laying and rolling with a smooth wheeled roller 8-10 tonne capacity and finishing to the required level and grade.

Cost of Tender Forms: -

0.2% of the quoted amount rounded to the nearest multiple of 100, subject to a minimum of Rs. 400/- and maximum of Rs. 1500 + GST 18%

Terms and Conditions: -

1. Tender should be submitted in the prescribed forms which can be downloaded from the website www.kau.edu/tenders. The cost of the tender forms will not be refunded under any circumstances.
2. The bidders shall quote their rates for the service to be provided as "RATE PER Sq. Ft." (in both words and figures) including all charges and the same would not be payable over and above the rates thus quoted.
3. The sealed cover containing the tender should be superscribed "**Asphalting work of severely damaged Farm road at PRS Panniyur**" (along with the notification number) and addressed to the Asst. Professor & Head, Pepper Research Station, Panniyur.
4. Each tender should be accompanied by tender fee and an Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) @ 1% of the total rupee equivalent cost of the quoted work by way of three crossed Demand Drafts separately (1. Tender fee 2.GST on tender fee 3.EMD) drawn in favour of Professor & Head, Pepper Research Station, Panniyur payable at the State Bank of India, Poovam Branch. The amount can also be remitted directly at PRS office before 18.03.2024, 3.00 PM. Late and incomplete tenders and tenders without EMD, tender fee and agreement will not be accepted. Firms which are exempted from payment of EMD should furnish copy of the current valid certificate from the Store Purchase Department, Government of Kerala.
5. The tender should be accompanied by an agreement in Kerala Stamp Paper worth Rs. 200/- (Rupees Two Hundred only) and format can be downloaded from the above website.
6. The bidder should have completed similar kind of work, the bidders should have GST registration certificate and furnish the copy of the same along with tender documents.
7. Successful bidder should execute an agreement in Kerala Stamp Paper worth Rs. 200/- (Rupees Two Hundred only) and should furnish a security deposit of 5% of the cost of the work quoted in the form either by cash or by demand draft term deposit/ bank guarantee/demand draft drawn in favour of the Professor & Head, Pepper Research Station, Panniyur payable at the State Bank of India, Poovam Branch. The format of the agreement can be downloaded from the above website.
8. The bidders are advised to visit the site during working hours (Monday to Saturday, 10AM to 5PM) before submitting the tender.
9. If any Bandh/strike/ any unexpected holidays occur on the date of opening of tender, the tender will be opened at the same time on the next working day. The decision of the undersigned in accepting the tenders shall be final and binding.
10. Withdrawal of tenders after its acceptance or failure to start the work within the time limit will entail cancellation of the tender.

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11. The work order will be issued on the acceptance of the tender and the invoice should be addressed to Asst. Professor & Head, Pepper Research Station, Panniyur payable at the State Bank of India, Poovam Branch. The payment will be effected only after satisfactory completion of the work.
12. The successful bidder should start the work within 3 days from the date of the receipt of the work order.
13. The Asst. Professor & Head, Pepper Research Station, Panniyur reserves the right to remove the name of the defaulted contractors from the list of contractors permanently or for a specific period.
14. After completion of the work the contractor has to submit necessary bill (including GST) at the office for payment.
15. Income tax @ 1%, KCWWF @ 1%, CGST @1%, SGST @ 1%, TDS on GST (if applicable) will be recovered from the bill during payment.
16. The Asst. Professor & Head has the right to accept or reject any or all of the offers without assigning any reason.

All the rules and regulations applicable to Government tenders will be applicable to this tender also.
